

Post Graduate Courses 2016-2017



Relational Mindfulness in Clinical Practices: 4-8 April 2016 (NB: This course is rarely offered)

Staff: Maura Sills, Founder and co-Director of the Karuna Institute

Cost: £675 (non-refundable deposit: £375)

This Diploma course is intended to give a preliminary grounding in the basic theory and practice of mindfulness within psychotherapeutic practice. Course introduces participants to key therapeutic contemplative practices and relational skills, grounded in the practice of Core Process Psychotherapy, one of the original mindfulness-based therapeutic forms.

Three-Day Craniosacral Biodynamic Post-Graduate Courses

The Primal Midline: 5-8 June 2016

An exploration into the ordering matrix and its primal midline. This seminar explores what is known as the "primal midline", the energetic midline within which the embryonic notochord forms and around which tissue organization develops.

The Three Functions of Potency: 4-7 September 2016

An exploration into the organizational, protective and healing functions of the primordial life force Dr Sutherland called potency. Dr Sutherland wrote of an energetic transmutation, or change in state, from primary respiration as Tide or Long Tide, into the fluids of the body, which generates an embodied life force that he called potency.
